Notice of Race

June 7 – 10, 2018 – Saltspring Island Sailing Club Facility

Saltspring Island, BC

The Saltspring Island Sailing Club and the Canadian Model Yachting Association invites International One Metre (IOM) sailors to the 2018 Canadian National Championship Regatta at the Saltspring Island Sailing Club, Saltspring Island, BC.

1. Rules:

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 and as modified by appendix E, the Equipment Rules of Sailing, The International One Metre Class Rules, the Sail Canada Prescriptions and the current version of SHRS Scoring System. Entry level will be kept to a number that will allow no more than 3 fleets to be sailed.

The switch from Qualifying Races to Finals Races is predicted to be mid-afternoon on Saturday. Until the entry level is known it is difficult to state how many Qualifying Races will be run. This timing should represent between $\frac{2}{3}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$ of the length of the event. The predicted number of races for the Qualifying rounds will be announced at the first Skipper's meeting.

After the first sentence of **RRS 20.1 Hailing** add "The competitor controlling the boat shall hail (her own number) Room to tack". This changes RRS20.1. NOTE: Sail Canada has approved this as an experimental rule change under the Sail Canada Prescriptions.

2. Eligibility:

Entrants must be current members of the CRYA, or their National Authority. Yachts must comply with the IOM Class Rules and have a valid Measurement Certificate. proof of Membership, Proof of valid PSN use and the Measurement Certificate should accompany the entry form, and/or be produced at event registration.

3. Schedule:

Event measurements and Practice:

Will take place on **Thursday June 7th, 1-5 PM** at the SISC Clubhouse. Friday AM measurement to be done only by special exception for out of town visitors; please inquire upon registration. Free practice will be available throughout this time.

NOTE: Any measurement for a Certificate needs to be done prior to check-in and event measurement. The race organization does not intend to allow time for initial measurement.

Racing Schedule:

- Conditions permitting, racing will commence on Friday after skipper meeting at **10:00 am**. There will be a break for lunch, and no heats will begin after **5:00pm**.
- On Saturday, racing will commence at **10:00am**. There will be a break for lunch and no heats will begin after **5:00 pm**.
- On Sunday, racing will commence at **10:00 am**. There will be no lunch break, and no races will begin after **1:00 pm**. There will be post-racing lunch prior to awards.

Social Schedule: There will be a social event on Friday evening that will be hosted by Rosemary and Martin Herbert at their home on Saltspring Island, 281 South Bank Drive starting at 6:30 PM. Food will be supplied but everyone attending is expected to bring along the beverage of their choice. There will also be the now traditional BBQ on Saturday evening following racing and held right on site at the SISC Clubhouse.

4. Entry and Fees:

The Entry Fee is \$90.00 CAD. Included in the entry will be: lunch on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday with BBQ dinner on Saturday evening. Prizes for the top 3 finishers in each of the Finals categories. Entries must be received no later than **May 24, 2018**. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Chairman. **Late Entry fee will be \$100.00**

Additional lunches and Saturday BBQ tickets can be arranged by filling in the appropriate information on the entry form. Additional lunches for all days will cost \$20 and additional BBQ tickets will be \$20.

The primary entry process will be to login to <https://secure.effreg.com/register/cdnonometre2018> and complete the entry form online as well as submit the required fees through the options listed there. Note that there is an option to scan and supply your Certificate presented by this system, but it is, as always, safest to carry a copy of all documentation with you and present them at check-in.

Manual entry can be accommodated if you fill out the entry form below, make out a cheque to “**Saltspring Island Sailing Club**” and mail it to: 152 Douglas Rd, Salt Spring Island, BC V8K 2J2. Make sure to mark the envelope with **IOM Nationals Entry** so that it can be routed correctly.

Shall comply with Appendix E 8. Country markings shall be present on all sails used during the event.

Arrival on Saltspring Island will involve some ferry travel. You should consult the BC Ferries website for current or forthcoming schedules.

NOTE: The Saltspring Island Sailing Club does not hold a license to allow the consumption of any alcoholic beverages on site. The Club and the Regatta Committee appreciate your cooperation in complying with this arrangement.
