- 1. The Corporate name is "Canadian Radio Yachting Association".
- 2. The registered office is situated in the province of British Columbia.
- 3. The minimum number of directors is 3. The maximum number of directors is 15.
- 4. The purpose of the Corporation is to promote the designing, building, racing and recreational sailing of radio controlled sailboats. This includes promoting competitive activities on a local, national and international basis a well as encouraging fellowship among radio control sailors. Among its objectives, the Corporation is to serve as the national organization for advancing the interests in common of Canadian radio control sailing clubs and to act on their behalf as occasion may require. The Corporation is a member of the World Sailing International Radio Sailing Association which recognizes the Corporation as the national authority for the competitive aspects of radio controlled sailing for Canada. The Corporation shall also maintain an affiliation with Sail Canada.
- 5. There are no restrictions on the activities that the Corporation may carry on.
- 6. The Corporation is authorized to establish one class of members. Each member shall be entitled to receive notice of, attend and vote at all meetings of the members of the Corporation.
- 7. Any property remaining on liquidation of the Corporation, after discharge of liabilities, shall be distributed to one or more qualified donees within the meaning of subsection 248(1) of the Income Tax Act.
