**Notice of Race** The Calgary Model Sailing Association (CMSA) invites IOM sailors to the 2019 Prairie Region Championship Regatta, Emerson Lake, High River, Alberta. The organizing authority is the CRYA in conjunction with CMSA.

**1. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (The RRS) and as modified by Appendix E, the Prescriptions of Sail Canada, the Equipment Rules of Sailing, IOM Class Rules and HMS Scoring System.

**2. Eligibility:** Entrants must be current members of the CRYA, or their National Authority. Yachts must comply with the IOMICA Class Rules and have a valid measurement certificate. Proof of membership and Measurement Certificate may accompany entry or be presented at check-in.

**3. Schedule:** Event Check in and measurement / inspection will be available at the regatta venue on August 23 between 12 noon & 4.30pm, *Measurement to be done only by special exception on Saturday morning for out of town visitors; please inquire upon registration.*

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first heat will be 11.00am on 24<sup>th</sup> of August and 11.00am on the 25th. No races will start after 5.30pm, 3pm Sunday.

**4. Entry and Fees:** **Entry fee is \$35**, and includes lunch on the 2 days of racing. There will be no host dinners in High River on Friday and Saturday evenings.

Entries must be received no later than **August 10th**. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Chairman.

Entries will be accepted on a first-come-first-serve basis. Entry will be capped at 36 skippers

Sail number conflicts will be resolved based on the date of receipt of paid entries including those accepted after the entry deadline. This overrides Personal Sail Numbers.
