RVYC and CRYA
2019 CRYA Western Region DF65 Championship
October 20, 2019**

- Notice of Race** The Royal Victoria Yacht Club invites DF65 sailors to the 2019 CRYA Western Region DF65 Championship Regatta at Royal Victoria Yacht Club, Victoria, BC. The organizing authority is the CRYA in conjunction with RVYC
- 1. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (The RRS) and as modified by Appendix E, the Prescriptions of Sail Canada, the Equipment Rules of Sailing, and the DF65 Class Rules V 1.6.
- 2. Eligibility:** Entrants must be current members of the CRYA, or their National Authority. Yachts must comply with the DF65 Class Rules and have a valid registration card. Proof of membership and Registration Card may accompany entry or be presented at check-in.
- 3. Schedule:** Event Check in and measurement/inspection will be available on October 20, 2019 after 08:00. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10:30. No races will start after 15:00.
- 4. Heats:** Entry is capped at 20 competitors to keep all boats sailing in a single heat. HMS single-heat scoring will be employed.
- 5. Entry and Fees:** **Entry fee is \$20**, and includes lunch. Please use one of the payment methods listed below.
Entries will open on **Sept. 04, 2019 at 00:01**.
Entries will be limited to 20 skippers in total. When entries open, the organizers will hold 9 spaces for mainland BC skippers, 9 spaces for skippers from Vancouver Island and the Gulf Islands and 2 spaces for non BC Region skippers for a period of 10 days. At the end of that period any remaining entry spaces will be given out to skippers in the order of receipt of their application.
Please make payment by etransfer to westcoastmarinesystems@shaw.ca. A separate email on security question/answer is appreciated. If etransfer is not an option, please contact westcoastmarinesystems@shaw.ca to make other arrangements.
Entries must be received no later than **October 13, 2019**. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Chairman. **Late Entry fee will be \$25**.
Sail number conflicts will be resolved based on the date of receipt of paid entries including those accepted after the entry deadline. This overrides Personal Sail Numbers.
- 6. Accommodation:** Entrants have a range of accommodation from which to choose. Victoria and the surrounding communities have a variety of hotel, motel and bed-and-breakfast options.
