

Dragonforce 65 Global Championship 2024 Report



1. Event Overview

The Dragonforce 65 Global Championship took place from May 10th to 17th, 2024, at the Nynäshamn Yacht Club in Nynäshamn, Sweden. The event was hosted in the picturesque surroundings of Strandvägen, a location renowned for its history of Olympic sailing races.

2. Event Schedule

- **Friday, May 10th:** Registration, measurement, and practice sessions.
- **Saturday, May 11th:** Continued registration, measurement, and practice sessions.
- **Sunday, May 12th to Tuesday, May 14th:** Racing days, with the first warning signal at 9:30 AM and no races starting after 5:30 PM.
- **Wednesday, May 15th:** Planned lay day, which could be used for racing if necessary.
- **Thursday, May 16th to Friday, May 17th:** Final racing days, with no races starting after 3:00 PM.

3. Venue and Organizing Authority

- The event was organized by the Swedish DF NCA and DF Sailing Sweden, in conjunction with Nynäshamns Yacht Club.
- The racing area was set in the Baltic Sea, providing challenging conditions for the competitors.

4. Rules and Regulations

- The championship was governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, DF65 Class Rules, and SHRS.
- Competitors were required to present valid personal sail number certificates, proof of membership, and emergency contact details during registration.

5. Measurement and Compliance

- The DFICA conducted check measurements and random spot checks throughout the event.
- Competitors had to present their rigs, batteries, hull, and appendages for compliance checks.

6. Entries and Eligibility

- The event was limited to 80 entries, with a staged entry process starting in October 2023.
- Entry fees were set at 350 Euros, covering racing, event clothing, memento, and participation in opening and closing ceremonies.

7. Prizes and Trophies

- A perpetual trophy was awarded to the winner of the event.
- Prizes were given for the top 10 places, along with various spot prizes throughout the fleet.

8. Risk Management

- Competitors were reminded of the inherent risks of sailing and their responsibility for safety and the decision to participate.
- The event provided a race management team and recovery boat assistance.

9. Additional Information

- The NHSS Club Pavilion served as the home base, offering amenities such as a bar, café, changing rooms, and parking facilities.
- Accommodation was available at nearby hotels, with special arrangements for mobile homes.
