NOTICE OF RACE  
Metro Marine Modellers  
Soling One Meter National Championship Regatta  
September 12 and 13, 2026**



- 1. Organizing Authority** The Metro Marine Modellers invites Soling One Meter sailors to the 2026 Soling One Meter National Championship Regatta at Lakefront Promenade in Mississauga, Ontario. This regatta is organized under the authority of the Canadian Radio Yachting Association (CRYA) and conducted by Metro Marine Modellers and its duly appointed Race Committee.
- 2. Rules** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (The RRS) as modified by Appendix E, the Prescriptions of Sail Canada, the Equipment Rules of Sailing, Soling One Meter Class Rules and the HMS Scoring System. Links to these documents may be found on the CRYA Web site <https://crya.ca/racing-documents/> or your class page. Rule E3.7 is changed to replace its wording with 'When a boat breaks R 30.3 or R 30.4, the Race Committee shall inform the boat'.
- 3. Eligibility:** Entrants must be current members of the CRYA, or their National Authority. Yachts must comply with the Soling One Meter class rules <https://www.amyclubs.org/Homeimages/ClassRules/14.pdf> and be registered with the CRYA or the relevant National Authority. Proof of membership may accompany entry or be presented at, or by, check-in.
- Competitors with a disability who require any form of help or special requirements should, prior to entry, get in touch with the club contact to confirm that suitable arrangements can be made. The onus is on the competitor to establish whether the available facilities are suitable and, if necessary, provide a suitable support person
- 4. Schedule** Event Check in and measurement/inspection will be available on the evening of Friday, September 11, 2026 from 4 pm until 7 pm and from 8 am to 9:15 am on Saturday, September 12, 2026. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 9:45 a.m. Racing will begin at 10 a.m. and no races will start after 3 p.m. There is no maximum number of races, however, a minimum of [6] races must be completed to constitute this event.
- 5. Entry and Fees** **Entry fee is \$75.50** includes temporary CRYA membership for this event for members in good standing of other National Authorities and includes lunches and refreshments on both racing days and draw prizes. Entry forms may be emailed to the Contact person below with the entry fee paid by e-Transfer to [treasurer@metromarine.org](mailto:treasurer@metromarine.org). Entry forms may also be mailed along with a cheque made out to Treasurer, Metro Marine Modellers at 20 Bonacres Avenue, Scarborough, ON, M1C 1P7. Please make payments in Canadian funds only.
- Entries must be received no later than **September 1, 2026**. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Chairman. The **Late Entry fee will be an additional \$10**. Entries may be capped at 20 boats on a first come basis. MMM reserves the right to cancel the event should there not be sufficient entries for a national level competition.
- Sail number conflicts will be resolved based on the date of receipt of paid entries including those accepted after the entry deadline. This overrides Personal Sail Numbers.
